Reflection - SYNOD 2020

We have been on the journey towards the Archdiocesan Synod since 2017. The first 12 months was a period of prayer and reflection leading to the National Eucharistic Congress in September 2018. The congress drew young people, women, men, religious, deacons, priests, and bishops from across England and Wales to Liverpool. During the next 12 months Synod Members were chosen in various ways, and they listened to the joys and sorrows, hopes and fears, of the people in their parishes. Over 27,000 responses were submitted to the Synod Working Group by parishioners and Synod Members. After a period of discernment by the Working Group, 4 themes were developed. 1 All called and gifted by God, 2 Sharing the mission of Jesus, 3 How we pray together and 4 Building Community and nurturing belonging. Synod Members and parishioners were invited, through a series of questions, to reflect on the themes that we 'felt drawn to'. From all of this: 120 proposals and 45 affirmations were developed for the Synod Members to spend time in further conversations and prayerful reflection, which will assist them as they cast their votes at the Synod on 19 June. The pandemic has changed the ways we have of engaging with one another and the Synod is being held, 8 months later than planned, via Zoom. Creative ways, using technology, have enabled us to meet as Synod Members along the way. During this coming week please pray for the Synod Members from St Wilfrid's and for all who will be participating on 19 June. A Pastoral Plan for the Archdiocese will be published by the Archbishop in Advent this year.
