CANON THOMAS NEYLON – ORDINATION AS BISHOP OF PLESTIA AND AUXILIARY BISHOP OF LIVERPOOL

The Archbishop of Liverpool announced on Tuesday 6 July 2021 that His Holiness Pope Francis has appointed Canon Thomas Neylon of the Archdiocese of Liverpool to be Bishop of Plestia and Auxiliary Bishop of Liverpool.

The Archbishop has confirmed that he will ordain Canon Neylon as Bishop on **Friday 3 September at 12noon** in the Metropolitan Cathedral of Christ the King.

There will be a coach leaving St. Bede's Church at 10am on the 3rd of September to the Cathedral. It will return to Widnes at 2pm after the ordination. There will also be unreserved seats in the Cathedral for people who wish to attend, and whilst tickets are not being issued, it would be helpful if anyone intending to celebrate this special occasion and will be attending the Mass should be advised to register their interest by emailing c.hanlon@metcathedral.org.uk

We would ask that you are in your seats by 11.30am.

Please note that parking will be restricted at the Cathedral.

Re-opening our churches ... the next step.

Due to the fact that the pandemic is far from over it is not the intention to restore an obligation to the attendance at Sunday Mass at this point.

People should be reminded of the importance of keeping Sunday holy and if possible, attending Mass weekly.

In preparation for the legal changes to Covid regulations that will come in to force on *Monday July 19*th this is what is being offered as the way forward for St Wilfrid's.

- Face coverings will remain mandatory for all those coming to a church service. (Exemptions for medical reasons excluded.)
- > Social distancing will not be mandatory in our churches. However, we would ask that you are conscious of others and their anxieties regarding space and the importance of keeping everyone feeling safe etc.
- A steward will be available to guide you when you enter but you will be able to choose your own seat.
- Hand sanitising will remain necessary as people arrive.
- > Benches will **not** be sanitised after each Mass.
- ➤ If you would like to sanitise your own bench before you sit down, please ask the steward for the spray.
- Votive candles can be lit.
- > Singing will be restored.
- ➤ The collection basket will not be passed around but will be available at the back of the church.
- The capacity of each church will include seating only and no standing.
- ➤ Holy Communion will be restored to its traditional place with a procession. Please continue to be mindful of peoples need for personal space.
- > Holy Communion under both kinds will not be re-introduced at this time.
- Mass will end in the traditional way.

Thank you for all your support in this ever-changing situation. I am sure we will all embrace the new rules as a step closer to a new normal.
