2025 is a Jubilee Year

My newsletter reflections over the last couple of weeks have focused on change and looking forward during the month of January. By the time this newsletter reaches you we will have had 'Quitters Day', the day when most people give up on their New Year resolutions. It is estimated that 88% of people give up upon their resolutions before the end of January.

But please, keep up your hope! After all, for us Catholics this is a special year, a Jubilee Year, a special year of forgiveness and reconciliation. It's a fantastic prospect. It's a whole year in which people are invited to come back into right relationship with God, with one another, and with all of creation.

A 'Jubilee' is often used to refer to the celebration of a particular anniversary of an event, usually denoting the 25th, 40th, 50th, 60th, and the 70th anniversary. Think of wedding anniversaries. The term comes from the Hebrew Bible, initially concerning a recurring religious observance involving a set number of years. This typically involved freeing of debt slaves. I doubt we can do this in Widnes!

In our Roman Catholic tradition, a Jubilee Year is traditionally proclaimed by the Universal Church every 25 years. It is a particular year set aside to encourage the faithful to embark on pilgrimages, to repent of their sins and forgive the sins of others, and to renew a focus on the spiritual life.

How exciting! Let's look forward to 2025 and make the most of this Jubilee Year!
