#### Catholic Relevance In The World

As I write this reflection at the start of the week, ahead of publication of the newsletter, the world is seeing some big changes. I'm thinking particularly about Donald Trump entering a second term in the White House. It moved me to reflect on his appointment, especially as I represented a Scottish government agency against him in a public inquiry before his first term as President.

His re-election got me thinking and wondering, 'does religion still play a role in world affairs?' It's true that since ancient times, religious beliefs and practices have been a powerful force in shaping morality, justice, values and the things that influence a society. But I wondered, does this still apply, particular in the USA, the most powerful nation on Earth?

About one-in-five adults in the USA are Catholic and Catholicism has long been one of the nation's largest religious groups. John F. Kennedy was the only Catholic president until Joe Biden was sworn in January 2020. Donald Trump used to describe himself as a Presbyterian, but he said in an October 2020 interview that he no longer identifies as a Presbyterian: "I now consider myself to be a nondenominational Christian." Almost all the USA's presidents have been Christians, and many have been Episcopalians or Presbyterians, with most of the rest belonging to other prominent Protestant denominations.

Catholics believe that participating in society is important because it allows them to serve others, promote justice and work to create a more peaceful world. The Gospel's message is clear: how we do in this world will depend a lot on how we treat the least of our brothers and sisters (Matt 25:40). As humans, we are social creatures by nature. By our nature, we must participate in public life to attain the common good of society and give glory to God (1 Peter 2:13-17).

We must work with the Holy Spirit to restore Catholic relevance in secular society because, if we don't, nothing will change.
