Reflection - REMEMBERING

I got caught napping this week. I remembered that I had to produce a reflection for the newsletter on Thursday afternoon. So, if this appears hurried, please forgive me.

One of the ways in which we are gifted by God is our ability to remember. From the moment of our first stirrings in the womb of our mother we begin to absorb and to learn. This learning continues throughout the whole of our life. I don't remember learning to walk but I do remember learning to ride a two wheeled bike. I still have the scars on my knees and elbows! The bike was gifted to us by John, who lived nearby, when he had outgrown it. It was a smaller version of the Raleigh bike that was very popular with men and women in our street when the cost of a car was much beyond the means of most adults. I remember my dad painting it so that it looked almost brand new. After many failed attempts I will never forget the day when I continued to pedal and stay in the saddle. This was a gateway to many happy hours, in the sunshine and the rain, of independence, freedom and adventures, with friends and neighbours.

The ability to remember serves us and the Church. We have personal memories which sustain our relationship with God and the members of the Church. When parents bring their child for baptism, they renew the promises that were made by their own parents and godparents on the day of their baptism. As youngsters or adults, we renew these promises when we are confirmed by the bishop. During the eucharist we hear the words of Jesus in the gospel: 'Do this in memory of me.'

We have become more aware of issues around the loss of the ability to remember among those at home or in the community, and others who support them. May we be sensitive to their needs and remember that forgetfulness or substantial memory loss does not dimmish human dignity.

Archdiocese's Synod 2020

The 'Synod 2020' weekend took place on June 19th/20th. Around 420 people, including Synod members from across the Archdiocese gathered together, on zoom and at the Cathedral Mass, for what was a culmination of all the sharing, listening discerning which has taken place in our parishes across the Archdiocese over recent years.

It was a remarkable experience of coming together as Church to review issues and make decisions.

What was the outcome?

Results:

Members were asked to vote on the 19 recommendations which had been compiled and drawn upon from the proposals originally received from Parishes/Pastoral Areas

Full details of this voting process, the recommendations voted upon and the results can be seen on the attached 'Synod 2020' leaflet.

The next steps: July 12th-July 16th 2021: Pastoral Planning Process

The results of the Synod, as well as all the work that has taken place over the last few years is being fed into a Pastoral Planning Process. From July 12th-16th the Archbishop, his Council and the Pastoral Plan Group will go away for five days to start to engage with this material. (Fuller details can been see on the Archdiocesan website). The Pastoral Plan to be launched on the 1st Sunday of Advent 2021.

Over these coming months let us continue to hold each other in prayer as together we discern a way forward for our Archdiocese and our Parish of St Wilfrid here in Widnes.


