Reflection.

On the 8th of December last year, the feast of the 'Immaculate Conception ' Pope Francis proclaimed ' the Year of St. Joseph '.

St Joseph is only mentioned a few times in the Gospel of Matthew and John. They refer to him as: Son of David, Husband of Mary and Foster Father of Jesus.

Pope Francis referred to St Joseph as " the man who goes unnoticed, a daily discreet hidden presence, who played an incomparable role in the history of salvation ".

St Joseph never utters a word in the scriptures, he is as we say ' seen but not heard '. He may be a man in the shadows but his silence is more than made up for by his actions and it is through his actions that we get a window into his character. He is seen as an honourable man in the way he dealt with the news of Mary's pregnancy and his decision to divorce her informally but later takes her home to be his wife. When Herod sought to kill his young son he quickly fled with his young family to safety in Egypt. Then finally returning home he settled in Nazareth where he built a home for his family; became a loving husband and father and provided for his family, working as a carpenter and passing on those same gifts to Jesus.

St Joseph is Patron of our Archdiocese with Our Lady Immaculate. His feast day is on 19th March. He is also Patron of Workers on May 1st.

He is Patron of the Universal Church: his name was inserted in the Roman Canon after Vatican II by Pope John XX III and Pope Francis had his name inserted in Eucharistic Prayers 2, 3 and 4. St Joseph is also Patron on the dying.
