

# My road to the Priesthood

The letter from the superior of Campion House Osterley arrived a week after my 23rd Birthday. it contained a long list of things I would need for collage but most importantly it gave me a detailed outline of my journey from Liverpool-Euston-Victoria underground-Osterley. A week later I was on my way.

Coming out of the station I was met by two second year students who took hold of my suitcases and walked me down the Great West Road to the college. That short journey broke the ice of my apprehension as I listened to the chatter of my welcome party. The superior Fr Alan Robinson was standing on the doorstep to greet me and handed me over to the head student who gave a quick tour of the collage.

That first 24 hours | felt like a fish out of water but soon made new friends and from that moment | never looked back. Although everything was new that sense of belonging to my new home was electrifying. | soon fitted right into the day-to-day routine although | found it difficult to rise at 6.30am.

There were 140 students from all walks of life ranging from 18-60, from all over the British Isles, USA, South Africa, and the Caribbean. The students besides studying, going to lectures in the morning had chores every afternoon and were responsible for all the housekeeping.

The timetable kept us busy, English Grammar, English Literature, Church History, French,

I he timetable kept us busy, Inglish Grammar, Inglish Literature, Church Mistory, I rench, Latin, Music, and Liturgy. Of all the subjects we studied Latin was my downfall but, in the end, I managed to scrape through with an O Level, and so on to seminary. I have many happy memories of my time in Osterley, made many new friends, some of whom have become lifelong friends.
