#### **Exciting news!**

We are delighted to announce, after two years of painstaking preparation and research, that approval has been given by Archdiocesan Trustees for the restoration works at St Bede's Church.

Already, arrangements are in hand to appoint a project manager, whom we hope to appoint before September, and for various expert contractors to submit tenders for the project.

At the same time applications will be submitted to the Historic Churches Commission, to ensure any proposal respects the historic character and integrity of this grade II listed building.

The successful contractor will draw up detailed specifications and obtain quotations for the repair and restoration works; this should be completed by the autumn.

Provided that everything goes according to schedule work should commence at the beginning of 2024, and a presentation of this exciting project will be made to parishioners later in the year.
