Medjugorje Pilgrimage

I continue my reflection of the recent pilgrimage to Medjugorje...

Every Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday evening, weather permitting, an hour of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and Benediction with prayer and reflection takes place on the outdoor altar following the Croatian Mass at 7pm.

This for me it is one of the highlights of the pilgrimage. Over the years I have taken part many times in Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and Benediction, but none have had such a profound spiritual effect upon my life as those that take place in Medjugorje.

The first thing you become aware of is the Silence, it's deafening. You can actually feel it which is incredible and hard to explain especially when you become aware that the number of pilgrims all around you, some 5,000 +, all of whom like you are deep in prayer with the Lord. Nothing distracts your inner peace from the moment the Blessed Sacrament is placed on the altar. Not even if, as sometimes happens, the rain comes down without warning, soaking everyone except the seasoned pilgrim, who never goes anywhere without a raincoat and umbrella. The time seems to stand still, and the hour is suddenly over as the priest intones the Tantum Ergo and the pilgrims stand and join in the singing of the hymn.

After the blessing an image of Mary is projected on two large screens either side of the altar for the singing of the Salve Regina. Then suddenly the place becomes alive with the sound of so many voices all speaking at once.
