

# **Project Zimbabwe**

Did you know that the first postage stamp in the world was issued here in Great Britain in 1840. It was the brainchild of Sir Rowland Hill. The Penny Black, which featured the profile of Queen Victoria was followed shortly afterwords by the 'Two Penny Blue' and the 'Penny Red'. All are highly sought after by collectors (Philatelists) and some, depending on their condition, could cost a thousand to a thousand five hundred.

All the above is an opportunity for me to thank all of you who have supported my appeal for used stamps over the past few years. Your recycled used postage stamp that otherwise would have gone into land fill, play an important role in the life of various charities and projects. The stamps are sold on to generate some of those vital funds that charities rely on.

This year your used stamps are going to help 'Project Zimbabwe 'that is run by Br. Benjamin from the parish of Bishop Eton in Woolton who looks after young children who have lost their parents to AIDS and are being brought up by an older sibling. None of these young children can attend school because they don't have a birth certificate and so are denied access to education. 'Project Zimbabwe 'will give that opportunity.

So can I encourage you to continue to bring your used postage stamps when you come to church and put them in the box in the church porch.
