Important notice for parishioners who donate to the parish by Direct Debit

During lockdown many parishioners set up Direct Debits to make their monthly offerings to our parish.

Some of these Direct Debits are not covered by a Gift Aid declaration. In such cases it means that if the person making the payment is a taxpayer, then the Parish cannot claim back the tax. As we all know Gift Aid raises many thousands of pounds every year for our parish.

As an example, for a parishioner who has Gift Aided donating £20 per month, our parish is able to claim back an additional £60 per year.

To enable us to ensure we have the maximum update of people on Gift Aid we would really appreciate *if anybody paying by Direct Debit could complete the proforma below and return it to the parish office as soon as possible.*

We can then check if the appropriate Gift Aid declaration has been signed.
