

Responsorial Psalm

R. God of Hosts, bring us back; let your face shine on us and we shall be saved

Stay Awake! Be Ready!

We move seamlessly from the Feast of Christ the King into the First Sunday of Advent, from the cross of Jesus to waiting in hope for His coming in glory! Are we ready? Are we awake? Or are we weary and unable to stir ourselves into action? The season of Advent calls us to reflect upon two certainties, that Jesus will come again 'in glory to judge the living and the dead,' and that He was born in time in space and became Emmanuel, God with us!

So, Advent gives us a strong message of challenge and comfort.

Challenge – Am I ready? Does my life radiate that Christ is at the centre of my life, my choices, my thinking, my attitude to others – am I open to change, to allow the voice of the Holy Spirit to call me into conversion of heart?

Comfort – We do not do this alone! Jesus came to live amongst us, to share totally in our lives, in our human experience. So, we should never be downhearted or afraid. He is with us! Turn to Him during this holy season of waiting, yet we are waiting in HOPE!
