We would like to remind you all that we are still very much around even though COVID restrictions have prevented us from visiting homes. It looks like restrictions are beginning lifted, and so we hope soon to be back visiting Our prayers are with you.

We would like to thank parishioner for their generous donations for the last financial year (April 2021 to March 2022). We received Church collections of £2600, and donations of £900.

Our expenditure was £2700, of which we spent £1200 on food vouchers, material assistance to families £550. And National Office SVP £509. Theses were some of our major costs during the year. We are expecting an increase in costs as conditioners are returning to levels of pre pandemic, with rising costs of living and heating bills.

We also give support to our schools and families when needed.

Once again, we thank you for your generosity in these austere times and we pray that the financial climate will soon get better.
