

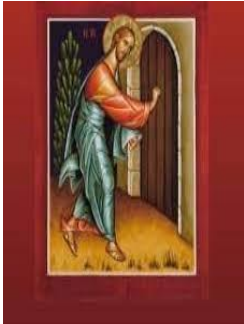

Deanery Synodal Council

A few weeks ago, the Warrington and Widnes Deanery Synodal Council (DSC) met for the first time. Deanery Synodal Councils are being established across the Archdiocese to help embed Synodality in every aspect of Archdiocesan life.

Our DSC is made up of parish representatives who will meet six times a year to pray, listen and discern how we can become the Church God is calling us to be, in Warrington and Widnes, with all the challenges that face us.

In future, reps will be elected, but to get the DSC off the ground the present reps have been chosen by the priests of the Deanery. As the work of the DSC unfolds, the reps will keep parishioners updated and help to implement the decisions of the DSC.
