The parish priest preached at every service, relatively briefly but very much to the point. I tried to work out whether he was reading his homily or simply speaking from the heart! Whatever, it was always worth listening to and left me with food for thought.

I remember all of this out loud for the St Wilfrid's Reflection because it also taught me how immensely rich we are in St Wilfrid's with all the gifts that are needed for a full celebration of the liturgy. Not every parish has such resources. We are able to have music at every celebration and that is an immense blessing. We have altar servers as we need them. We are blessed with great readers as, I have to add, was the parish I was in, and then there are all the backroom people without whom our liturgy would struggle.

So, while I really immersed myself in that parish for the week and was greatly rewarded, I had my moments of yearning for the churches of St Wilfrid's, Widnes.
