Saturday 2nd November – Mass for all the Faithful Departed, St. Bede, 10am.

At this Mass we pray for all who have died, and everyone will be offered a bottle of holy water to take to graves or places of remembrance to bless and pray.

Sunday 10th and Sunday 17th November – Mass for all who have died from our parish in the past 12 months, St. Basil's, 4pm.

At these two Masses the names of all who have died in our parish community in the past 12 months will be read aloud, to call them to mind, to pray and to thank God for them.
