

Our Church in Widnes

A parish working together thrives on shared faith, communication, active participation and mutual support to build a vibrant, unified community focused on serving both spiritual and social needs. For a parish to function as 'one', members need to cultivate a spirit of togetherness rooted in their shared beliefs and mission. This includes welcoming all parishioners, fostering open communication, and encouraging involvement in parish life, from liturgical ministries to social outreach.

The current challenges presented to us regarding the future of St Michael's church in the parish of St Wilfrid have put these things into sharp focus, but it seems that we are in a strong position.

What we know is that there are heating and building quality issues with St. Michael's church that have precipitated a necessary engagement with the Archdiocese to inform their decision making regarding its future.

In response, and not on a timescale of our making, the parish Vision Group organised open meetings for parishioners in St. Basil's club, St. Michael's church and St Bede's church to capture the feeling and comments of parishioners. We also invited comments by e-mail.

Every written comment received will be submitted (with names redacted) to the Archdiocese this coming Monday 15th September. These will be accompanied by a factual summary overview of the comments received and a covering statement reflecting the overall sentiments of parishioners, while also stressing the uniqueness of St. Michael's church for Widnes in several important aspects identified by parishioners, as well as its parish functions for the wider Widnes, possibilities for growth and its historic, cultural and architectural importance.

Resulting from the parish consultations, this submission drafted by the Vision Group will ask for more time to discern the future of St. Michael's church to ensure that wise, well informed and sustainable outcomes are taken by the Archdiocese for this church.

Thank you to everyone that has engaged so positively with this consultation. We will make the submission available to view for parishioners. More details to follow.
